

RISE HIGH Grant Partnership Program Compliance and Reporting

Organizations selected are required to submit a close-out report to Neighborhood Allies within thirty (30) days of the final expenditure of awarded funds. Reporting requirements will vary based on the proposal and will be stated in the contract documents.

All awarded grantee-partners must track and report on the following impacts/outcomes:

- · Amount of RHGP funds expended.
- Number of individuals served/impacted.
- Amount of administrative costs (capped at 20% of the total awarded funds).
- · Source and amount of all matched/leveraged funds.
- · Equity and inclusion impact and results
